### Objective

To promote a certain aesthetic solution to suit the design and focus of the hotel whilst providing privacy for its visitors and minimising light and glare penetration to the building. The structure is situated around the Realm Precinct, meant the solution needed to reflect and complement the theme of the hotel's identity whilst promoting the city through its interior views and rooftop lounges.

### The Solution

Maintaining the high standard required of the hotel, the solution was to fit different blind systems into the hotel which consisted of roller blinds and aluminium venetians. The unique identity of Burbury hotel was to focus on polarising themes, "black and white" and contrasting personalities overall. Different timber venetians finishes were used for Burbury hotel to suit the idea and create a subtle dramatic essence to the vibe of the hotel.

Approximately 2250 blinds: aluminium venetians and roller blinds installed into suites, offices and apartments. Roller Blind Systems included manual and motorised roller blinds, some with side channels to complete the overall vision of the hotel.
